Grievance Redressal Committee - Process:

M.A., M.Phil, Ph.D.

- Grievance Redressal Committee shall consider individual grievances of specific nature of students.
- The Grievance Redressal Committee shall not consider any grievance of general applicability or of collective nature of raised collectively by more than one student.
- After the receipt of the complaint the committee is at the liberty to decide on the merit of case regarding scope of further discussion or inquiry and act accordingly.
- Grievance Redressal Committee shall redress grievances within a reasonable time.
- If need be, the Grievance Redressal Committee will give a report to the authority about the cases attended to and seek guidance from the higher authorities if required.

Scope:

Students are at liberty to lodge grievance about any academic and non-academic matters related to -

- Timely issue of Transfer Certificates, Conduct Certificates/ Character Certificates or other examination and scholarship related matters.
- Issues related to bus pass.
- Matters pertaining to the library- extra books for home issue, extension of timings, issue of no dues certificate and payments for loss of books.
- Grievances about conditions of sanitation, drinking water or such related matters.
- Grievances related to Sports gym timings.
